October 2022 REPORT

MARKETING

Hosted the Kansas Economic Development alliance in Salina for their Fall Conference on September 27th and 28th. Governor Kelly and Lt Governor Toland spoke to the conference. Approximately 110 people registered for the conference. Republican Lt Governor candidate Katie Sawyer also spoke to the conference. Salina was recognized for several recent successes including the \$25 million for housing as well as \$22 million for the River Project.

KS Salina was able to announce the largest corporate give in Kansas State history with a donation from General Atomics for \$10 million donated for use in a simulation center project on the local campus. A local team had visited the GA headquarters in San Diego, CA in 2019.

WORKFORCE TALENT / HOUSING

Had multiple sessions with Leadell Ediger concerning childcare projects being considered here in Salina and Saline County. Met with City of Salina planning staff concerning childcare needs. Also met with County Administrator Phillip Smith-Haynes concerning possible county grant funds to be used for childcare development.

Maxwell Drever had met with the City Commission several times discussing his housing project planned for the western part of Salina including the former hotel site.

ETREPRENEURSHIP / SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

Local business owner Jason Bathon was the October Startup Salina program on October 6th.

Planning our next meeting to discuss the 2nd Annual Charley Walker Entrepreneurial Challenge. The date is set for Friday, March 24th.

PROSPECT MANAGEMENT

Jeff Maes has continued to work with Project JR landowners. Second landowner is not receptive to selling the property and wants to develop it themselves. The company owner and his building director visited Salina and met with local building officials as well as a local engineering firm that will be doing early-stage development plans.

Project American Memory has eliminated Salina and the State of Kansas from consideration for this semiconductor facility. Project Stamper is an aviation project that Dept of Commerce project we submitted a site for. Salina was also eliminated from this project. See the October Prospect Table for more information on all the project looking at Salina.

The Great Plains project to change rail service north of their plant has changed with rail now needed for their future needs. The engineering firm is working with Great Plains and the UP on working out a possible plan for changes.

Developer interested in Salina for a new truck stop complex met with Development Review Team at City Hall to discuss a location on the west side of Salina along Interstate 135. The developer now has cost estimates related to the project.



This past week I arranged a meeting with a local group of individuals who are developing new technology that can be used by the medical profession to identify cancer and other health issues. They met with two local medical professionals and reviewed the equipment for three hours. The local group will be meeting via a Zoom call with KU's Dean of Radiology to discuss a possible visit to Lawrence for a demonstration of the equipment.
